Committees will be formally established upon a majority vote by the Board. Establishment and disbandment of all committees shall be noted in the minutes by the Secretary. Each Committee shall elect a Chairperson from among its members. Committees shall determine how they will conduct their business. They shall report on their activities in writing at each meeting of the WANC. Committees will be comprised of three (3) or fewer Board members.
