Coordinated by the Chief Sustainability Office (CSO), the County is creating its first ever Youth Climate Commission, which will make recommendations, offer ideas, and provide input to the Board of Supervisors on the County's climate-related goals, plans, actions, policies, and initiatives. Each County Supervisor will appoint 5 commissioners for their own District, for a total of 25 Commissioners countywide. The County is committed to an inclusive recruitment process and invites young adult leaders from all backgrounds and communities to apply.

ELIGIBILITY

- Los Angeles County resident
- Identify as a young adult aged 18 years or older

COMMITMENT

- Commit to a 1-year or 2-year term
- Complete trainings, including Brown Act training to understand how to conduct public meetings
- Actively participate in an annual retreat and during the Commission's quarterly meetings (in person and/or virtually)
- Be motivated to stay informed on issues related to climate change and engage LA County residents under 18

OPPORTUNITIES

- Civic engagement and leadership development
- Mentorship and networking opportunities
- Attendance/participation in LA County events/activities (where possible)
- Stipend (\$300 per meeting)
- Participation in meaningful dialogue with LA County leadership
